PUBLIC HEARING ON REDISTRICTING OF THE KTJUSD BOARD OF TRUSTEE AREA BOUNDARIES

NOTICE is hereby given that the Klamath-Trinity Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing on February 8, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., at the District Office Conference Room, 11800 State Highway 96, Hoopa, CA to invite and solicit public comment on proposed trustee area map adjustments.

The Klamath-Trinity Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees consists of seven elected members. Each trustee represents a trustee area that corresponds to a geographical region of the school district. Trustees are elected only by voters residing within their respective trustee areas, otherwise known as a "by-trustee area" election. After the decennial federal census, trustee areas may be reapportioned to assure that populations within the areas remain nearly equal. As a general rule, the variation in total population among trustee areas must not exceed 10%. No changes are needed if the total peak variation is less than 10%. If the total peak variation exceeds 10%, trustee area boundaries must be adjusted. This process is referred to as redistricting.

Klamath-Trinity Joint Unified School District hired local consulting firm, Planwest Partners, to study the 2020 Census data and determine whether the current trustee areas are population balanced. The redistricting process and draft map options will be presented during the February 8, 2022 public hearing. A final map adoption hearing will subsequently be held on February 24, 2022.
