

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Trustees of the Klamath-Trinity Joint Unified School District ("District") will hold a public hearing and invites public testimony on the matter of seeking a waiver from the State Board of Education, pursuant to the requirements of California Education Code section 33050, relating its available bonding capacity for general obligation bonds of the District. The District has issued a portion of the amount of bonds authorized by the voters under a single measure known as Measure "H" in Humboldt County and Measure "S" in Trinity County, passed on November 4, 2008, and has issued a portion of the amount of bonds authorized by the voters under Measure "D," passed on June 7, 2016, and seeks a waiver from the State Board of Education on its bonding capacity in order to issue the remaining \$930,805 from the 2008 authority and \$3,300,000 from the 2016 authority, totaling \$4,230,805 in bond authorization approved by the voters.

The hearing will be held at 5:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on December 18, 2018, at the District's Office, located at 11800 State Highway 96, Hoopa, California.
